**Abe Lincoln** will set the stage for your trip to the past when he visits you the first night after dinner. You will travel to 1859 – to the beautiful historic town of **Harpers Ferry**, West Virginia, where a man named **John Brown** set in motion an event that led to the Civil War conflict. Some say he was crazy, some say he was a saint – you decide.



Move to 1862 – to the small town of **Sharpsburg**, where the soldiers met and fought as the South attempted to invade Northern soil. More than bullets and bayonets, it is the human stories of how and why the battle of Antietam

unfolded and became the bloodiest day in the war.

In 1863 the Southern Army succeeded in invading the north as they headed to Harrisburg, and planned to march from there into Washington DC. However, as they marched to Gettysburg to gather, the North discovered their plan and stopped them. Both sides believed that this was the final battle and fought as such. It is an incredible story.



Complete your experience by walking Pickett's Charge (if you wish), touring the National Cemetery and hearing the Gettysburg Address where it was first read.
